- 5 countries attending (Australia, Fiji, Indonesia, Japan, New Zealand) + 1 country – Thailand providing overview of activities
- 4 organisations (IUR, SPERA, IAEA, SETAC-Australasia)



Agreed common objectives

- Strategic Research Agenda (Asia-Pacific)
- Modelling and assessment
 - improve/better integrate Asian/Pacific data (e.g into ERICA; ASPAMARD)
 - Asian diet modelling (human exposure)
- Improved communication and visibility of activities

- Input to MODARIA-II
- Capacity building
 - Training
- Shared platforms
 - Laboratories
 - contaminated sites
- Strengthen linkages with SETAC both at global and regional level

Recological isk Protection of Radioeccology Potential timeline: Actions from Bali

- Revise and distribute new ToR for regional task group end 2016
- Identify research priorities
 - Present at IUR Global FORUM May/June 2017
- Conduct survey of potential shared platforms (via IUR)
- Strengthen co-operation IUR-SPERA-SETAC and others
- Work with IUR/ERICA consortium to improve ERICA tool and organise ERICA course
 - Consider UNSCEAR Research Priorities
- Regional Technical Cooperation (IAEA) proposal due Feb 2018
- Joint conference/workshop strategy or plan for IUR/SETAC/SPERA
 - Plan a regional IUR/SPERA conference for 2018?
